Charlap Hyman and Herrero is a duo composed by Adam Charlap Hyman and Andre Herrero. Graduates of the Rhode Island School of Design in furniture design and art history (Charlap Hyman) and architecture (Herrero), the American duo live and work between New York and Los Angeles.

Recent projects include *Walden*, a group exhibition at Schloss Hollenegg, Austria, 2020; *Home Stories: 100 Years, 20 Visionary Interiors* exhibition and publication at Vitra Design Museum, Germany, 2020; *For Mario* exhibition at Tina Kim Gallery, New York, 2019; *Ouvrez-Moi* exhibition at ALMA ZEVI Project, Venice, 2019; the collaboration with Vitra for their Autumn 2020 collection at Salone del Mobile, Milan; the set design for Amsterdam's Royal Theater Carré, 2019; a collaboration with Cynthia Talmadge for *1076 Madison* at 56 Henry, New York, 2018 and the the exhibition design for *Blow Up*, curated by Felix Burrichter at Friedman Benda, New York, 2018. In 2018, they curated the exhibition *Of Purism* at Nina Johnson Gallery, Miami and they also ranked among Forbes Magazine's "30 Under 30" in their art and style category. CHH were the 2017 winners of the Miami Design District's holiday decoration competition and in the same year were selected to participate in the Chicago Architecture Biennial.
